Likewise, the new streamlined, floating shelf with chamfered bottom beneath the handle-free wall cabinets offers contrast by accentuating the linear, minimalist design theme, while keeping with the curved counter base for continuity. As a result, the SieMatic 6006 has recaptured the groundbreaking revolutionary design of the 1960s SieMatic kitchen transcending into the 21st century.
